

RULES

Summer Camp

For the youth group to function well at Summer Camp, obeying and respecting adult leadership is essential. By allowing a teenager to go on a trip, parents agree to allow adult leadership to make the final decision about discipline. On all camps and retreats the following is expected.

BEHAVIOR:

1. Treat every person with respect, kindness and courtesy.
2. There will be a chaperone in your room.
3. Do not enter the room of the opposite sex without an adult.
4. Always be on time for meetings.
5. You are required to get up by breakfast, and go to bed at lights out.
6. No water balloons, shaving cream fights, fireworks or practical jokes of any kind.
7. No horseplay, fighting, name calling, aggressive behavior, or bad language.
8. If you break it, you pay for it. If no one claims guilt, the whole room pays for it.
9. Obey any camp, retreat, hotel, or facility rule.

FREE TIME:

1. Free time can only be spent in designated areas supervised by a chaperones.
2. Youth are required to check back at assigned times.
3. Free time must be spent in groups of two or more.

DISCIPLINE:

Youth will be immediately sent home for:

1. Possessing alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco products, guns, pornography, or causing danger to themselves or the group.
2. Leaving the group without permission.
3. Sexual promiscuity.

ELECTRONICS:

1. Laptops and console game systems are not allowed.
2. You are financially responsible for any damage, loss or theft of any personal electronics.

DRESS CODE

We believe it is important to be specific about what vs. what isn't appropriate. This dress code has proven to provide effective Biblical boundaries for modesty.

On all camps and retreats these standards apply.

1. We reserve the right to determine what clothing is inappropriate or immodest.
2. Youth will be asked and expected to change or cover inappropriate bathing suits or clothing without argument.
3. Shirts and shoes must be worn to all meal times and group meetings.
4. Pajama bottoms, leggings or yoga pants are not allowed.
5. No T-shirts that promote drugs, alcohol, or vulgarity.

"Girl's Shorts, Tops & Bathing Suits"

1. Shorts must fit loosely = permitted
2. No rear showing = permitted
3. Tops must latch in back = permitted
4. No cleavage showing = permitted
5. Girls will be asked to wear a dark T-Shirt over their bathing suit if it doesn't meet our dress code.
